- * The Hep B requirement will be progressive.
- * The two doses of MMR is currently required of all students in grades K-2 and 7-12. It will continue to be progressive in grades kindergarten through 6th until 2006-2007, when it will be required of all students, K-12.
- * The requirement of 5 DtaPs if the fourth dose was given before the fourth birthday will apply on to students entering kindergarten.
- * The requirement of 4 doses of Polio will apply to all students if they received a combination of OPV and IPV. Students who received all OPV or all IPV and received the third dose on or after the fourth birthday, do not need the fourth dose.
- * This will continue to be progressive until 2001-2012 school year when it will be required for all students in grades K through 12.

All the vaccines listed above will remain a requirement for all students including transfers from other schools within the state, other states, and other countries.
