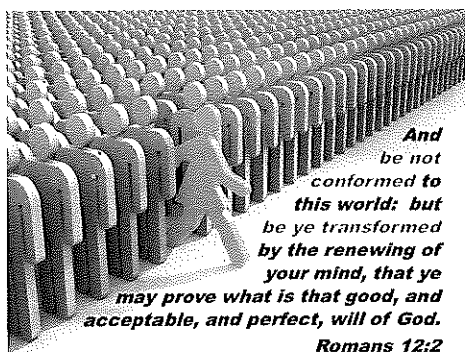

Message from the Medical Staff

The school nurse and speech pathologist will be available at the Get Acquainted Night to perform vision and hearing screenings. We are required to screen new students to the school and students in preschool, kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, & 9th. If you have time, please bring your child for screening. The screenings should only last about 5 minutes.

Also, please bring completed emergency medical forms (EMI), Over The Counter (OTC) medication and Prescription medication forms, as well as any updated vaccine records or exemption forms if not already turned in. All medical forms must be completed and turned in to the school by September 9th. If we have not received the EMI form by September 9th, your student will not be allowed to attend school until we receive the form.
