REMINDERS from the Medical Staff

- * Emergency Medical Forms (EMI), Over The Counter (OTC) medication and Prescription medication forms, as well as updated vaccine records or exemption forms are due at this time. If we have not received the EMI form by September 9th, your student will not be allowed to attend school until we receive the form.
- * Under NO circumstance should a student bring any medication, including cough drops, to school. This would be a violation of school policy. If you have medication that the school needs to have on hand for your student, the <u>parent/guardian</u> must bring it into the school office. There is a form that needs to be signed by the parent/guardian when dropping medication off.
- We need your help to keep our students happy and healthy. We need to make sure our students are drinking enough water. Please send your student with a refillable water bottle daily to refill throughout the day at one of our several filtered water stations. The current recommendations are for children to drink their age in 8-ounce glasses until they reach the age of 8. Children 8 and older should drink eight 8-ounce glasses of water per day. If you have a 6-year old, he or she should be getting six 8-ounce glasses per day. The best thing to teach your child is to look at their urine. Many kids will find this funny at first, but the color of the urine can help let a child learn about hydration status. Urine should be clear to straw color. If it is dark yellow or looks like apple juice, then your child is dehydrated and needs to drink more water. We tell kids that they want to have urine that hardly colors the water in the bottom of the toilet when they start to pee. Early morning urine is usually the most concentrated so kids should try to get their urine to become clearer throughout the day.




