Dear Jefferson County Christian School Family,

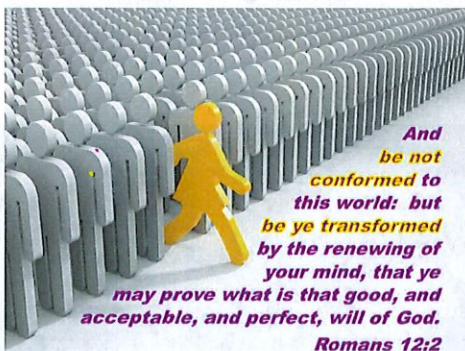

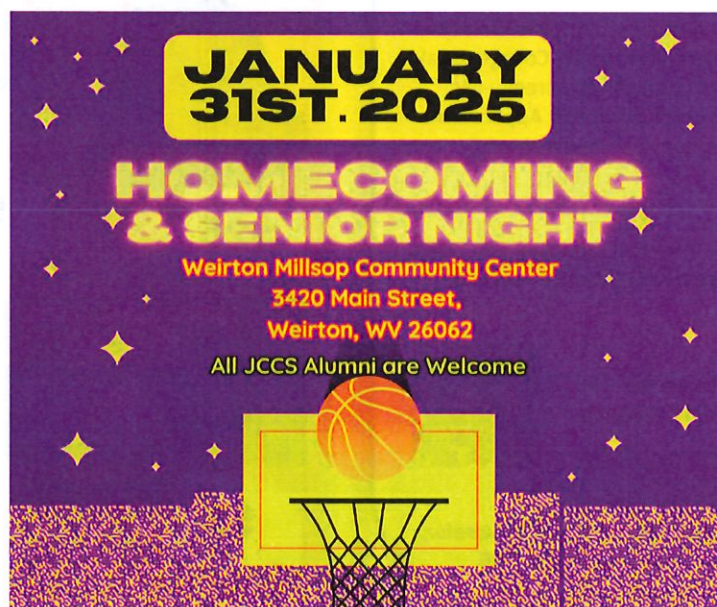
